



HOW TO JOIN

membership costs \$120 for a capital share. This can be paid annually in \$20 increments over 6 years. Please read our membership agreement, detach and mail in your membership form. You can add in your first produce order with your membership fee. **Members receive a 5% discount on all store items**, can order produce shares and participate in a biweekly order through the UNFI catalog.

HOW TO ORDER

the share system Each week you have the choice to purchase a half, full or fruit share. Decide what's right for you and your family on a week to week basis.

- [\$18] A half share consists of a basket of seasonal produce that could feed two adults.
- [\$35] A full share consists of a basket of seasonal produce that could feed a family of four.
- [\$5] A fruit share consists of roughly 4-5lbs of seasonal fruit.

An order form is not necessary to place your order. Simply send in a check with your total.

Orders must be received by Saturday at 4pm for pick up the following Wednesday between 3-6:30pm at our distribution site in the Orange Innovation Center, Room #222.

MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT

The North Quabbin Community Co-op provides its members with mindfully selected products at the lowest possible cost. To keep costs low and in the cooperative spirit, we need members to volunteer. Though we do not require members to volunteer, we suggest you set aside 3 hours of your time every month to help out in some way. Working members receive a 20% discount on produce the week they volunteer. Please contact northquabbinfoodcoop@gmail.com to find out how you can volunteer. There are many different things you can do on Wednesday distribution days and other days of the week. Thanks for your support!

- Members must abide by the rules and regulations of the North Quabbin Community Co-op. Our bylaws are available in hard copy form at the distribution site and on our website.
- Each member is issued a membership card which contains a member ID number. One membership is entitled to one vote in the annual meeting in addition to other member benefits as determined by the Board of Directors.
- Membership with NQCC is an at will commitment. You agree to hold harmless and indemnify from loss or damages all volunteers and coordinators of the NQCC.
- Orders must be placed and paid for by mail or drop-off by 4pm on the Saturday before pick-up.
- Produce pick-up is on Wednesdays between 3-

6:30pm at the Orange Innovation Center, Space #222. You can find us easily by following signs from the front entrance. There is a handicap entrance at the rear of the building. We are located next to the gym.

- Any unclaimed produce from shares will be forfeited. There are no substitutions or refunds on shares. Please bring your own bags or boxes.
- Checks received with insufficient funds will incur a \$35 fee. Two bounced checks will result in the co-op insisting on a money order or cashier's check.
